EXNORA

Mr.Appavu is a committee member from EXNORA, the organization provides street cleaning services through about 17,000 streets, 40% of Chennai city and 75% of the suburbs, and some other parts of Tamil Nadu. The street cleaning service includes a collection of garbage at homes, sorting at pickup, composting organic waste, and generating income for the "street beautifiers" through the sale of recyclables. The chapters also work with the local corporations and municipalities to address civic problems including sewage leaks, water supply problems, and repairs to street lamps.

The organization's Environmental Training Institute conducts training programs for school teachers on environmental issues such as biodiversity, climate change, and solid, liquid and zero waste management. The teachers are taught how to turn a home into a green building and set up vertical gardens.

Summary :

A Guest Lecture on Waste Management was organized by Mr.Appavu from EXNORA organization on July 17th 2018 for NSS Volunteers in the Natya Block of Dr. MGR-Janaki College of Arts & Science for Women at 2 p.m.

Future basis ideas and waste management concepts were explained to the NSS Volunteers. Mr. Appavu explained what are Bio-Degradable and Non Biodegradable Wastes. He spoke about ways to reduce the wastes generated in our homes, factories, industries, refineries, power plants, hotels, hospitals and dispensaries. He also told us to reuse and recycle waste as much as possible. He instructed us to avoid using plastics and other materials that are harmful to the environment. He concluded by saying that if Wastes were not managed properly, that it would lead to pollution. This in turn would lead to environmental degradation and affect all living things on Earth. Saidai Samiyappan Duraisamy

He is the first All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (AIADMK) candidate to become the Mayor of Chennai from 25 October 2011 to 24 October 2016. He is also the founder and chairman of Manidhaneyam IAS academy, a free coaching academy for the aspirants of the Civil Services Examination, in Tamil Nadu.

Duraisamy was elected to the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly in 1984 from Saidapet.He stayed away from politics after the demise of M. G. Ramachandran.He contested the 2011 assembly elections as a candidate for the AIADMK from the Kolathur constituency, which he lost. He contested the mayoral election of Chennai corporation, and became the first AIADMK mayor of the city, in October 2011, winning the election by a margin of over 5.19 lakh votes. He took the oath of office on 25 October.

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CPR (Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation)

A guest lecture on CPR (Cardio pulmonary resuscitation) was given by DR. Balu of VHS Multi-specialty hospital in seminar hall -1 for 50 RRC volunteers of DR.MGR Janaki College of Arts and Science For Women on September 20, 2018 at 10.30 am .







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Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is an emergency procedure that combines chest compressions often with artificial ventilation in an effort to manually preserve intact brain function until further measures are taken to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person who is in cardiac arrest. It is recommended in those who are unresponsive with no breathing or abnormal breathing.

He taught us about the use of CPR and gave a brief on how to do it. He made a demo how to do a CPR with the help of the volunteers there. We learnt many useful information about CPR and further this technique would help us to perform to those who are in the urge of emergency.

The lecture ended at 12.30 pm and the volunteers found the lecture to be very informative and gained a lot of knowledge about it.
